

messy freely.**

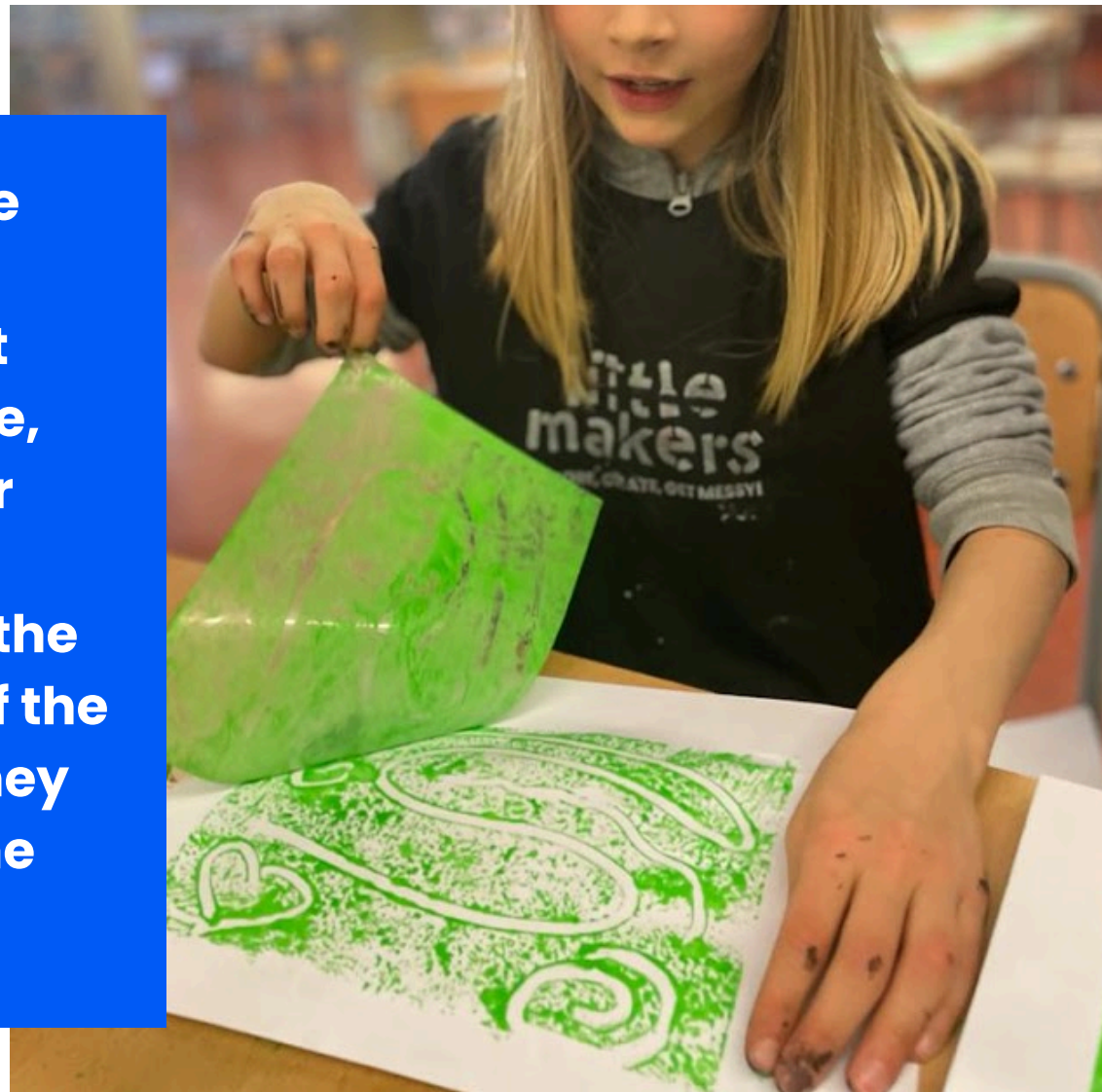
We want to empower

We encourage divergent and creative thinking, helping children explore multiple perspectives and find unique solutions to problems.

We encourage children to experiment at their own pace, following their interests and emphasizing the importance of the creative journey rather than the final product.



WHY PROCESS ART?

Process art focuses on the act of creating, experimenting, and discovering, rather than the final product itself.



WHAT IS IT?

Children explore to discover new materials, techniques and tools in an open-ended way, without a predefined outcome.

- The art is unique and original.
- Project ideas are given, but artists are encouraged to experiment and discover.
- There are no step-by-step instructions to achieve a unique result.
- **There is no example for children to follow.**
